

## Daily reminders:

**Each day,** children should bring their Home / School diary into school, along with their library book, and take it home at home time. This is excellent practise for secondary school.

## <u>Spellings:</u>

The Year 6 Spellings list will be going home on Monday 11th September.

Spellings will also be set on Spelling Shed from Week 3 (W/C 18.09.23). The login will be stuck into their Home / School diary.

Spellings will be tested every **Friday** in the back of their Home / School diary so children can share their weekly scores with home.

## <u>Reading</u>

We would like children in Year 6 to be reading their library book **four or more times a week** and would recommend reading for **20 minutes** each time. Children or adults might choose to record reading by jotting down any notes in their Home / School diary.

## <u>Maths</u>

Children should practise their times tables using TT Rockstars, the login to which can be found in the Home / School diary. We will be setting **weekly online Maths homework** using a platform called Atom. This will commence in Week 3 (W/C 18.09.23).

## <u>PE:</u>

PE kits are to be worn on **Tuesdays and Thursdays** during this half term (Mondays and Thursdays next half term).

Children are to come into school in their school-expected PE kit on these days.

Some children, who have not yet achieved their end of KS2 swimming objectives, will be **swimming on Tuesdays.** ParentMails have been sent if this applies to your child. Please ensure they bring in correct swimming kit; they may still wear PE kit on Tuesdays.

#### Make up and Jewellery

A polite reminder that nail varnish, make-up and all jewellery (other than a single pair of studs) are not permitted to be worn in school by pupils.

#### Homework projects

Children are asked to complete a project related to their current learning each half term. Additional information about this is on a separate letter.
