

## COVID-19 How to deal with symptoms in a member of staff or pupil in a school setting

Updated 22<sup>nd</sup> January 2021

It is vital if a member of staff or pupil **starts to** develop symptoms (high temperature, new continuous cough or loss or change to sense of smell or taste) that the school/educational establishment takes immediate action.

Use the following flowchart to determine what actions to take, as advised by Public Health England. Please note that this advice is subject to change. **Following the latest guidance, the period of self-isolation for contacts has now reduced to 10 days. The reduction to 10 days will apply retrospectively to close contacts already isolating.** If prior to December 14<sup>th</sup> a close contact had been notified to isolate for 14 days, this is now reduced to 10 days. This means that from Monday 14<sup>th</sup> December, close contacts who are on the 11th, 12th, 13th or 14th day of self-isolation, have completed their 10 day isolation and may return to school.

If you have **one positive case** of Covid-19 in your setting, please email a completed [checklist](#) to the BCC Public Health Team at [contacttracing@birmingham.gov.uk](mailto:contacttracing@birmingham.gov.uk); do NOT contact Public Health England.

If you have **2 or more positive cases** of Covid-19 in your setting, **please email a checklist to [contacttracing@birmingham.gov.uk](mailto:contacttracing@birmingham.gov.uk) as well as** contact Public Health England on [WM.2019CoV@phe.gov.uk](mailto:WM.2019CoV@phe.gov.uk) or 0344 225 3560 and press 0 then option 2.

**Please submit a checklist as soon as possible to support with the risk assessment. There's no requirement to submit a separate checklist for each case as long as the individual cases are identified as case 1, case 2 and are referred to consistently within the checklist. If part of the same situation/ outbreak, additional cases can be added to previous checklists, but they must be highlighted and referred to clearly as being additional and relevant info must be updated accordingly.**
